## **2012 Medical Program Accomplishments**

- Served more than 43,000 patients, a 15% decrease from last year.
- Offered round-the-clock emergency services, treating 2692 patients, (2660 cases were treated at our own hospital, while only 32 cases were transported to city hospitals for specialized care.)
- Provided 24/7 service with two ambulances in a 30-mile radius.
- · Housed 806 patients at our 12-bed hospital.
- Performed 105 surgeries.
- Delivered 54 babies.
- · Conducted 402 lab tests.
- Treated 125 tuberculosis patients with a full course of treatment (treatments can take up to 9 months), up 38% from 2011.

## **2012 Prevention Program Accomplishments**

- Added 12 new villages to the prevention program, increasing the total number of villages being served to 48.
- Served 6 Kindergarten schools in our prevention program.
- Supplied 2227 children with nutritional supplements and vaccinations, up from 1558 in 2011.
- Provided 366 pregnant women with prenatal care, nutritional supplements and vaccinations, up from 184 in 2011.
- Conducted 576 health education seminars in 48 villages, up from 432 in 2011.
- Family planning program increased significantly, again this year:
  - √ Visited 7783 pregnancy-age women throughout the year on a bimonthly, rotating basis for one-on-one meetings to build relationships and provide family planning consultations, up from 7097 in 2011.
  - √ Distributed 107322 condoms and 87987 birth control pills in our family planning program.
  - √ Counseled and Transported 399 women to the Block Government Hospital for tubal ligation, up from 278 in 2011.

## **New Programs 2013:**

- Constructed toilets for 14 local schools. 10 new schools are planned for 2013. A lot of girls above 12 years of age drop out of school due to the lack of toilet facilities at school premises. This project is expected to result in significant reduction in girls' dropout.
- Continued the scholarship program, started in 2011, at the Nandeshwar Bal Vidya School: 6 new students received our scholarship in 2012.
- 300 cataract surgeries.
