Children receiving Nutritional Supplements: IVC provides nutritional supplements to children and pregnant women, vaccination, family planning services and health education for all. We serve approximately quarter million people per year in our curative and preventative healthcare programs in the poor villages of northeastern India.

Annual Report 2017

2017 Medical Program Accomplishments

- Served 37,435 patients
- Offered round-the-clock emergency services, treating 2926 patients, (2914 cases were treated at our own hospital, while only 12 cases were transported to city hospitals for specialized care.)
- Provided 24/7 service with two ambulances in a 30-mile radius.
- Admitted and treated 742 patients in our 12-bed hospital.
- Performed 56 surgeries.
- Delivered 25 babies.
- Conducted 47 lab tests
- Treated 68 tuberculosis patients with full course of treatment (treatment can take up to 9 months)



2017 Prevention Program Accomplishments

- Served 60 villages and 28 Kindergarten schools in the prevention program
- Supplied 1667 children with nutritional supplements and vaccinations, a 25% increase from last year
- Provided 412 pregnant women with prenatal care, nutritional supplements and vaccinations, a 45% increase from last year.
- Conducted 720 health education seminars in 60 villages
- Family Planning Results:
 - ✓ Visited 7800 pregnancy-age women throughout the year on a monthly, rotating basis for one-on-one meetings to build relationship and provide family planning consultation
 - ✓ Provided 33919 condoms , 3655 Mala Ds, 59 Copper-Ts and 40 multi-loads
 - ✓ Counseled and guided 360 women to the Block Government Hospital for tubal ligation and 1 man for vasectomy

New Programs in 2017

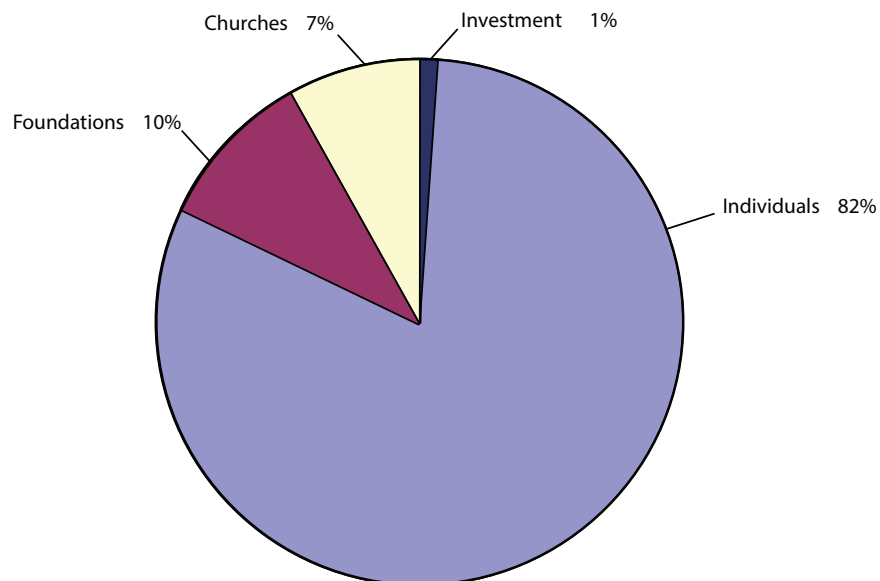
- 110 cataract surgeries
- Continued scholarship program, started in 2011 at the Nandeshwar Bal Vidya School
- 6 new students received our scholarship in 2017
- Started a brand new program this year: English medium school for village children

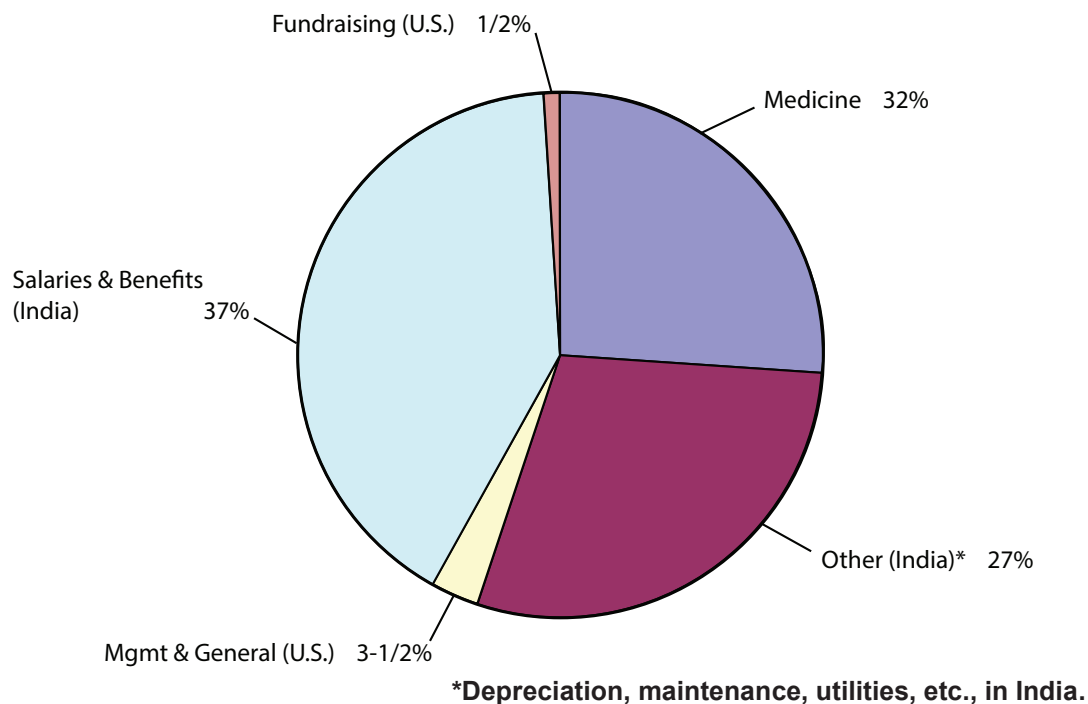
